More than Friends

No more cookie-cutter versions of the hairstyles from the TV success *Friends*, said stylist Ugo Tabardel of l'Ultime Coiffure International.

A *Friends*-style cut took hours to do but in the end gave nothing more than an unkempt look, he said.

Volume, the big-head look, is making a comeback but with a shapier, more sculptural curve that can be brushed loose for casual wear.

To get this look on actress Jacinthe Pilote, Tabardel dried the hair with a round boar's-bristle brush. To give it body, the hair is pulled upward while being dried.

For a more casual natural look, he suggests teasing the hair from the roots, using the fingers or a wide-toothed wooden comb.
